REAWAKEN IN US THE AWARENESS OF OUR PILGRIMAGE TO YOU

By this Sunday next week, we shall have celebrated Christmas the birth of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. I take the opportunity to wish you all a Merry Christmas and a blessed New Year 2025.

I thank you all for your fidelity to Christ and to the Church as a whole and to our parish community. We do not come to church just as individuals but as a community, since we know that when we leave our homes to go to Church, we are going to meet other worshippers. Thank you for entertaining this sense of community in building up our parish.

We come to the end of this year 2024, with heavy hearts because of our parishioners that have died. However we must look at it from the other side by saying: what benefit would life bring to any believer in God, if it was not to know that one day we shall be united with him!? It is on that account that while humanly we count our losses for those who have departed, it gives us joy that they are finally in the presence of Jesus. The day of their departure from us, will forever remain as their day of arrival in the presence of God. For this we are thankful.

The generosity of the people of this parish is remarkable. That generosity is inspired by the conviction of each one of us that we are called by the same Lord, to work in the same vineyard and to receive the same pay which is God himself.

In the New Year, I ask you that we continue to deepen our sense of mission. We are like soldiers deployed in this part of the Church in the world, to do our bit. Therefore we must aim at pulling our forces together by having profound respect for the elderly because of their experience as Christians and members of the Church for longer time and by being so supportive of the young because it is they, who will take on the good work we are doing

On 24th, the Holy Father will open the Holy Door of the Basilica of St. Peter in the Vatican to inaugurate the Year of the Jubilee. On 29th, he will open the Holy Door of his cathedral church of St. John Lateran which on 9th November will mark 1700 years of its consecration. On 1st January 2025 solemnity of Mary mother of God the Holy Father will open a Holy Door at the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the walls. These last three doors will be closed on Sunday 28th December 2025.

Let us walk together as pilgrims of hope, let our actions be inspired by hope, for we are not labouring in vain. Archbishop Bernard will open a Holy Door at St. Chad's Cathedral on Sunday 29th December. Please pick up a copy of the Jubilee Year booklet.
