Deanery Meeting at St. Anne's was held successfully last Tuesday. Thanks to the parishioners Linda Glover, Margaret Hutchinson and Mr. Reggie, who provided lunch to the priests after the meeting. It gave a very good image of our parish for which I'm grateful.

Following up Parish & Diocesan Appeal - thank you to everyone who has already responded so generously to the appeal we launched at the start of the tax year. While we have received a great response, many are likely still discerning their contribution. We still welcome your support as we work together to meet our parish goals. Gift Aid envelopes are available at the back of the church. To update your financial support to the Church you will need to go to the bank to update your Standing Order mandate.

This year our Annual Pentecost Feast will be a fundraising event to support Church expenses. It will be held on **Pentecost Sunday 24th May at 12:30pm**.
