Parish Loan To St. Osburg's - Coventry

Some of you might know St. Osburg parish in Coventry. It is the first Catholic Church to be built after the Protestant Reformation; therefore, it holds the prestige title of Mother Church of that city. The foundation stone was laid in May 1843, the nave was opened for Mass in 1844, the church was completed and consecrated in 1845 by Bishop Nicholas Wiseman. Sixteen (16) parishes in Coventry have been created and developed from the same stock.

Due to the restoration of the Church, the parish ran into extra financial need which left the parishioners with a huge bank overdraft. The Archdiocese of Birmingham being a single charity, when one parish runs into unprecedented financial need, it might affect other member churches. Some parishes, through falling attendances, have not been as fortunate and have run into financial difficulties and now have large bank overdrafts that cost them dearly in interest charges. For the case of St. Osburg, Archbishop Bernard has approached some parishes through the Dean of Coventry and Nuneaton Deanery asking for a soft loan to be rendered to the parish to stop the increasing bank interest charges that are making the overdraft become more insolvent. I have consulted with the Parish Finance Committee, and we have collectively agreed that we should respond to the Archbishop's request by granting **a soft loan** of £20,000.00 (twenty thousand), which will reduce the bank interest charges considerably. This money is to be paid back, and it will **not** affect our financial ability to do all the good works that we have planned for the future.

I trust that you agree with this decision. I'm grateful with the people of our three churches who have been generous with their financial support. Thank you too for using the property of the parish including water, electricity and gas sparingly. Every saving helps as it serves the common good.
