**Change of Mass time** please note that on 1<sup>st</sup> April, all priests of the diocese will join his Grace Archbishop Bernard, in renewing their priestly commitment and also, with him, to consecrate the holy oils at St. Chad Cathedral. Mass will be celebrated **only** at Our Lady of the Angels at 9:00am to enable the priests to travel to Birmingham.
