I'm interested in the history of the churches I have worked at and of the Institute of the Apostles of Jesus to which I belong. When you know the history of something, you appreciate what it is and avoid anything that might tarnish its history. I admire the stained-glass windows of our three parish churches of Our Lady's, of St. Anne's and of St. Joseph's, but I don't know who came up with the idea or the sponsors of these windows. It is important that we keep them in perpetual good memory. Stain glass windows are very expensive; sponsors would have used the money for some personal pleasure; but spending it on our church building is a great legacy they leave for us. I'm glad to announce that the last stained-glass window at Our Lady of the Angel's Church has been donated and fixed. This completes the work of adorning the church with stained glasses which started many, many years ago. Who are the donors?

The window behind the Organ was donated by Margaret and Carmel Cauchi in memory of Fr. Benjamin Cox who was parish priest for 15 years 1945-1960.

The window of St. Thomas More and the English Martyrs was donated by Janet and Stan Banks of good memory to remind the people of this parish of the faith of our fathers.

The Window of Padre Pio was donated by Doherty family in memory of their son Patrick Pio Doherty who died in 2013 aged only 13 years.

The window of Our Lady of Walsingham was donated by Hugh and Anne McAteer to remind the parishioners that they are beloved children of the heavenly Mother.

The window of St. Francis of Assisi was donated by Sas and Philip Jennings inspired by Pope Francis encyclical Laudato Si calling on us to take care of our planet.

The window portraying St. John Henry Newman was donated by someone who wishes to remain anonymous. It shows Blessed Dominic Barberi receiving him into communion with the Catholic Church.

Each window reflects the devotion, faith and spirituality of its donors. I'm thankful to you all for the sacrifices you make to keep the church running. How could the church operate without your generous support! The window at the back high above the organ pipes is underway too. Please think of supporting a group of seminarians in their formation to become missionary priests. May God bless you all.
